

Deep Cleaning – what should I do?

Our current infection control procedures will cover any contamination.

A deep clean isn't going to solve any problem as there won't be virus in those hard to get into places.

Our advice is to clean all hard surfaces (handrails or cupboards etc as well as door handles , i.e. any item regularly handled) with our approved cleaning products from supplier (Zenith etc) and to wash all soft fabrics, sheets, towels etc on a normal wash .

This should be repeated after each suspected virus case where staff or service user has had contact with hard or soft surfaces.

Additional help to combat any potential infection should focus on regular hand washing, cleaning down door handles and being vigilant ensuring cleaning regimes and infection control are restated and prioritised with all staff on site.
