We specialise in providing placements for young people who require an assessment of need in conjunction with a recommended transitional plan.



- An integrated model of therapy, care and education, using the trauma recovery model to assess a childs needs.

- Weekly case reviews with the MDT team to review each case.

- Direct clinical oversight with regular reviews and progress reports.
- MDT measurable outcomes.
